- To encourage every lay minister at our Lord's altar to have a progressive rule of life based on the Sacraments
- To instill within each lay minister an interest in proper liturgics within their branch of the Church
- To encourage knowledge, understanding and preservation of traditional rituals
- To pray that all members will consider their service as Lay Minister to be a vocation

The Objects of The Order

- To promote holy living among its members
- To promote loyalty and full cooperation to clergy and lay leaders
- To encourage regular attendance at the Holy Eucharist, and more careful preparation for its reception
- To promote unity in Christ and friendship and brotherhood among lay ministers
- To teach the complete Sacramental Faith as taught in the One, Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church, and to promote the practice of the same

- To pray each morning and each night
- To be faithful in the reading and study of Holy Scripture
- To make due preparation before the service and to say the Order's prayer
- To attend Mass and receive Communion, if possible, every Sunday and Holy Day, and to be duly prepared through self-examination and confession
- To fully cooperate with, and support the clergy and other spiritual leaders
- To always speak reverently of Holy Things and when in Holy places
- To pray for the Order and all her members
- To pray for the unity of the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church
